Numeracy Activities;

Estimation

- Estimate how many people are on page 7 and 8.
- Estimate how many pools are in the book.
- Estimate how many fires are on page 21 and 22.
- Estimate how many people are on the train on page 2.
- Estimate how many animals are in the book.

Time

- What time does it show on the clock on page 20?
- If they got on the hot air balloon at 6.15pm what time did they get off if they got off 3 hours and 15 mins later?

Number

- How many fish are in the big tank at the aquarium?
- In one hour there are 25 cars on the bridge. How many cars will cross the bridge after 5 hours?
- How many sharks were in the aquarium?
- What page is the crane on?
- How many cars on page one?
- 35 people went into the shopping centre and bought 6 toys each. How many toys altogether?
- If there were 42 cars going over the bridge in 1 hour. How many cars went over the bridge in 2 hours?
- Tickets to the Zoo cost \$10. The ticket to the aquarium cost \$15. The train ride cost \$20. How much did it cost for each person to do all these things?
- There were 68 people on the train. 24 people got off. How many people were left on the train?

Measurement

- Measure how wide the book is.
- Measure how tall the tallest building in the book is and then times it by 2. What is the answer?
- Which would be heavier – the book In The City or a dictionary? Why?

Shape

- How many different shapes are on page 4?
- How many rectangles on the middle page?
- What shape was the building on page 2?
