ACTIVITY	FOCUS	Activity Details
Literacy 1	Rhyming words	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Read story— ‘Ten Friendly Frogs’. • Identify any rhyming words. • Brainstorm a list of rhyming words—relate to THRASS soundboxes. • Complete rhyming activity in book—teacher to write a list of words and the children need to find a matching rhyming word. • Children to share findings.
Literacy 2	Writing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Discuss how each page has been written. • Read other number stories. • Students to come up with their own examples and share them with the class. • Students will write there own number stories using the numbers 1 to 5. • Students to share their work.
Numeracy 1	Tens facts	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Read through the text discussing each number and counting visuals on each page. • Talk about making each number to ten. • Using tens frame children draw frogs, then work out how many more are needed to make ten. • Children can complete activity independently then share with a friend.
Numeracy 2	Rainbow facts	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Remind students about tens facts from past lesson. • Demonstrate rainbow facts. • Students to complete their own rainbow of tens facts. • Early finishers can find matching pages that equal ten.
