Numeracy Activities:

- Draw a picture that has lots of things, 1 thing, 2 things, 3 things etc.
- Make a monster and measure all the parts.
- Write number stories with monsters using all of the operations.
- Order numbers.

- Find some even numbers in the story.
- Skip count by 2s from a variety of numbers.
- Choose a number and write down some equations.
- Create a monster using shapes.
- Count monsters.
- Count the numbers on the number plates.
- Order the numbers on the number plates.
- Create a symmetrical monster.
- Find biggest/smallest numbers.
- Create some equations using presents.
- Make a timeline of day/night.
- Hide numbers.
- Create a board game and practise counting forwards and backwards.
- Make a pattern of monsters using different colours.
- Add up all of the pages in the book.
- Count all of the different shapes in the picture.
