GRADUATION WALL HANGING QUILT

Dear Parents,

Today, your child has been given a piece of calico which needs to be completed for the 2008 Graduation Quilt. You will have two weeks to complete the task so it is due back at school no later than **Wednesday, 12th November**. This project requires considerable time to compile and sew together into the large wall hanging. Therefore, we ask each student to complete their square by the due date.

REMEMBER:

- ❖ Double check that you have the **top** of the calico at the **top** before you start.
- ❖ Use only the calico square given to you.
- ❖ If you make a mistake on your square and can't fix it, please ask us for a replacement.
- ❖ Sew on attachments. Many pieces have fallen off in the past because they have not been sewn on.
- ❖ If it is not possible to sew an attachment on, you **must** use **craft glue**.
- ❖ Use the calico as the backing and add your bits and pieces to it. Please try not to make it too heavy as it is then difficult to sew and the finished wall hanging does not hang well.
- ❖ Do not create your design outside the designated borders on your piece of calico because these will be sewn over.
- ❖ Avoid using slang words, nicknames and alternative spelling such as "friends for eva".
- ❖ Check your spelling very carefully.
- ❖ Do not dye the calico before starting.

All the best with your handiwork! Go for it!
